## **Brief Introduction and Application Form**

### **Introduction :**

Way Young Dragon Boat Club ("Way Young") was founded on the 14th of October, 2006. It is registered as a non-profit organization. "Way Young" in Chinese means gathering hundreds of rivers and congregating them into a mighty ocean (i.e. the Club welcomes all active and energetic dragon boat athletes irrespective of origin, age, race and gender and train them into a formidable force). Way Young is supported by a group of enthusiasts with a common vision to promote dragon boating; to congregate friends of similar interests; and to encourage greater participation in this water sport through a series of well organized, systematic and professional trainings. ### **Objectives :**

1. To promote and popularize the sport of dragon boating;
2. To enhance willpower, improve dragon boating techniques and strengthen the body through systematic and professional training;
3. To rely on consistent training and participation in dragon boat competitions / activities, and to strengthen team;
4. To enhance dragon boating culture and technical improvements through multi-national exchanges and co-operations with other sister clubs in Hong Kong and overseas;
5. To actively participate in local and overseas dragon boat competitions or related activities so that "Way Young" will become a driving force for promoting Hong Kong's dragon boating sport.

### **Fees :**

- Regular Members: HK\$900 per year\*
  - Student Members: HK\$400 per year\* (only applicable to persons aged 17 or above, full time high school or tertiary level students)
1. Competition Fee: With the exception of Student Members, all participating members are required to pay HK\$150 per competition as their share of the competition expenses.
  2. Paddles: The club will provide standard wooden paddles used for training only but strongly encourage members to purchase their own club paddle for use in competitions.

(\* Annual fees include regular training sessions, basic locker storage facility, dragon boats maintenance, part of registration fees for competitions and personal accident insurance coverage; in order to confirm eligibility status of membership, annual fees must be settled every year on the first regular training session. The Club reserves the right to increase/decrease the annual fee in accordance with its financial status).(Rev. 2016)

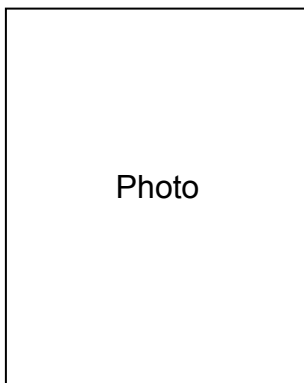
